This Amendment answers the following questions:

Questions and Answers (10/27/2014)

(1) When looking up this Solicitation Number, HHS-NIH-NCI-SBSS-TSB-47001-42, we noted that there is a draft SOW from August 2013 with a specified due date of August 15, 2013. As this date is in the past, what is the actual due date?

Answer: The Due date of the Solicitation is December 8, 2014

(2) We see that this program has an anticipated start date of June 2014, is this accurate?

Answer: The anticipated period of performance is 1/15/2015 - 1/14/2020

(3) Finally, because of the confusion over the specified timing, we have a question about the status of this contract. Was this contract already awarded to a Prime, and is the Prime now intending to subcontract specific parts of this program?

Answer: No contract has been awarded

(4) Could you please clarify what number should be used for the Small Business Plan, The total IDIQ amount or the sum of Task 1 and all Sample Tasks?

Answer: The total IDIQ Amount.

(5) The solicitation includes the Service Contract labor Standards clause, FAR 52.222-41. However, I could not locate a wage determination in the solicitation. The contractor requests confirmation that this effort will be subject to the Service Contract Labor Standards clause. If so, would you please provide a copy of the applicable wage determination for Menlo Park, California?
