This is a Research and Development (R & D) Sources Sought notice. This is **NOT A SOLICITATION FOR PROPOSALS, PROPOSAL ABSTRACTS, QUOTATIONS, and COST OR PRICE PROPOSALS**. The purpose of this sources sought notice is to perform market research and to gain information regarding the availability and capability of qualified sources to perform a potential R & D requirement. **POTENTIAL INTERESTED PARTIES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO RESPOND TO THIS SOURCES SOUGHT NOTICE TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR ANY POTENTIAL R&D REQUIREMENT IN THE FUTURE**

Capability Statements:

Submission of a capability statement addressing the **nine Task Areas** in the draft SOW is considered responsive. A capability statement is defined as a brief outline of an organization that is trying to contract work with a government agency. This statement describes the organization, its capabilities and its expertise in relation to the draft SOW.

Sample Task Orders:

Responses to sample task orders A&B are **NOT** required as part of potential interested party's' capability statement. The purpose of the draft SOW and mandatory criteria in this R&D sources sought notice is to allow potential interested parties a better understanding if they choose to submit a capability statement. Additionally, the draft SOW has been provided to allow potential interested parties the ability to become familiar with SEER.
